#### **Tour Martin Guitars**

The folks at Martin will be prepared to provide tours. Travel in your own cars (or carpool) on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday. (Martin is closed on the weekend!) Since Martin workers start very early (6:45 am) and hence finish the day very early in the afternoon (2:15 pm), the ideal timing to arrive for ASIA tours would be the time period between 11:00 am - 1:15 pm. Tours typically last about an hour, plus it is vital while you are at the factory to see the Martin Museum and 1883 Shop, which are open until 5:00 pm daily.

As a visitor on the factory floor, your guided tour will show you how our guitars come to life through the hands of the craftsperson. Explore the art of guitarmaking, from old world tools to our state-of-the-art facility. Follow a guitar from rough lumber to a finished product which requires more than 300 steps to complete. Tours last approximately one hour. Photographs are allowed without a flash. Video cameras or recorders are not permitted. Cell phones are permitted for capturing images. Closed-toe shoes are recommended. The address is 510 Sycamore Street.
